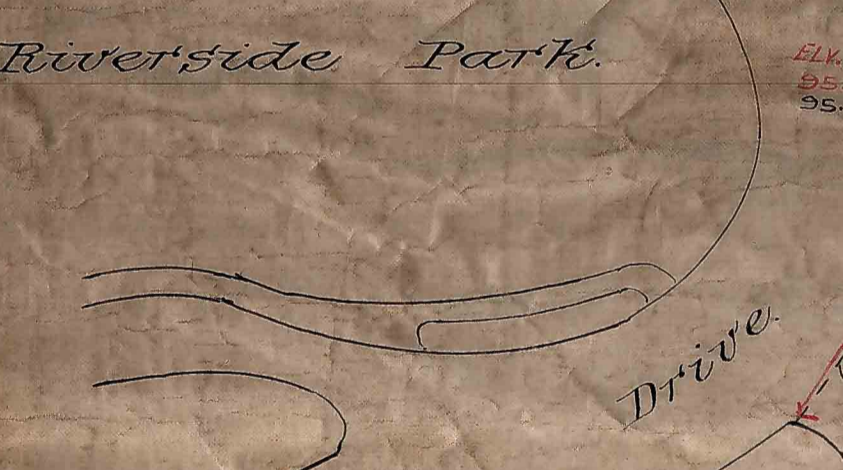

The Board of Street Opening and Improvement of the City of New York, by and under authority of Chapter 665, laws of the State of New York, passed May 22nd 1897; does hereby certify that this Map or Plan is one of three maps or plans in all respects similar, which this Board has caused to be made and has directed to be filed in the manner provided by said Act; showing Section No. 1—Elevated Extension of Riverside Drive and Parkway along and over 12th Avenue from near 127th Street to 135th Street in the City of New York as an Extension of Riverside Drive to Boulevard Lafayette; with Grades Fixed and Established for said Drive and Parkway, and for connecting streets, in the 12th Ward of the City of New York as laid out and opened by this Board on the _____ day of 1897.
