 as amended by Chapter 272 of the Laws of 1888, and by Chapter 257 of the Laws of 1889.

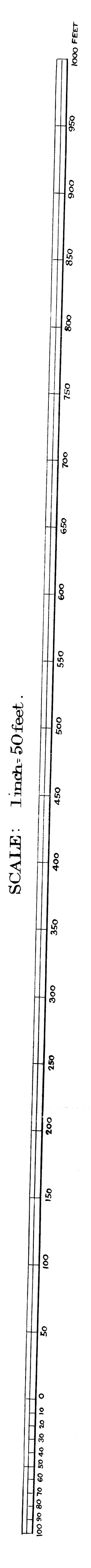
The grades of the Exterior Street are fixed by the Department of Docks at 5 feet above city datum, high water on its easterly line, and at 7 feet above city datum on its westerly line throughout its entire length. These grades are shown in RED figures.
